

Construction Update — Thursday 5 December 2019

Key activities for Stage 1 tower

- The majority of the 14-storey tower ground floor slab has been poured.
- Two concrete placing booms have been installed onsite. These structures are used to pour concrete in areas that a concrete truck can't access.
- The North West Jumpform (structure that allows vertical concrete pours) is now operational, which means you'll see the western staircase growing quite quickly.
- The North East Jumpform assembly is progressing well.
- The high voltage (HV) works are now complete along Fragar Road and Jamison Street, with the HV works along Derby Street on track to finish in early 2020.

New childcare centre

- The concrete for the main ground slab has been poured, forming the foundations of the new childcare centre.
- Following the completion of the concrete pour, the outer wall of the childcare centre along the Great Western Highway will be erected this month.
- Whilst work on the outer wall will not disrupt the hospital campus, two lanes will be closed along the Great Western Highway, so please remember to drive carefully and pay attention to pedestrian signage.
