

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE NEPEAN REDEVELOPMENT



THURSDAY 22 AUGUST

The Stage 2 construction site is a hive of activity. Excavation works at the site of the new Stage 2 tower building is almost complete which will be followed by the first pour of concrete to make the ground slab of the new building only weeks away.

Construction of a temporary loading dock for the hospital is continuing with demolition works at the old Pharmacy and Microbiology departments. The loading dock is being temporarily relocated to the northern end of Building D while Stage 2 construction is underway.

Meanwhile, the team is working with CPB to finalise all the remaining detailed design elements including the landscaped courtyards and green spaces surrounding the new Stage 2 tower building.

Boring and piling works at the site of the new Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) Unit are now complete. The first ground floor slab is scheduled to be poured in a matter of weeks.
